Academic Programme

Students at Oxford College studying elective subjects receive a total of 41 hours of academic development during their two-week course, consisting of 15 hours of subject specific tuition through our Elective Courses and 4 hours of University Preparation each week. Students will also have 3 hour academic workshop linked to their elective subject as part of the London excursion during their two-week course. Classes are multinational and a maximum size of 15 students. All courses culminate with a Time to Shine Presentation.

Foundation English

Foundation English is for students with an A1 or A2 level of English who want a college style experience in Oxford. Students will receive 41 hours of academic development during their two-week course, including 38 hours English tuition and one 3-hour academic excursion.

Travel & Transfers

Summer Boarding Courses offers an Airport Transfer Service to the Oxford College Summer School for any flights landing at London Heathrow Airport. This will be in operation throughout the scheduled arrival and departure days and available for flights arriving between 06.00 and 17.00 and departing between 09.00 and 17.00 at a cost of £90 per journey. For any queries about flights scheduled outside of these times, please speak with your Student Support Manager before finalising your transfers.

Welcome Club

On each arrival day for students travelling by coach from Heathrow Airport, we provide a safe and welcoming base for students to recoup following their flight and wait comfortably before the coach departs. Welcome Club offers refreshments, entertainment and a place to unwind and to meet other students arriving for their courses before the journey to the school. Welcome Club will be supervised by our transfer team who will encourage students to contact home, if they haven't already done so, and ensure that they are well organised and have all their belongings before boarding the coach.
